The purpose of this addendum is to clarify the desired response to the RFP, which is to receive one proposal which includes two options:

1. Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)
2. Environmental Assessment (EA)

Cobb County will award a contract for one of the options above to the successful proposer based on further guidance from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).

**The following sections of the RFP are being revised as follows:**

**Section 1.2 Purpose of the Project**

The Cobb County Department of Transportation (Cobb DOT) requests consultant services for the development of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). The EIS shall be developed concurrently and fully integrated with the on-going Northwest Corridor Alternatives Analysis (AA) Study. A detailed description of the scope of the project and the specific tasks required to complete the scope of work are outlined in Section 4.

Because the environmental resources in the I-75 and US41 corridors are similar in nature, Cobb DOT is interested in receiving a proposal that includes a Scope of Work and Methodology for both an Environmental Assessment (EA) and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). Proposers are reminded, however, that the NEPA class of action required for the Northwest Atlanta Corridor project will be determined by the FTA.

**Section 3.6 Proposal Format**

Each Proposal must include the following information, presented in a clear, comprehensive and concise manner. The Scope of Work and Methodology outlined in Section 4, should be limited to 15 (8 ½ by 11 inch) pages of text in which the consultant will describe the proposed work program, approach and methodology to be used to complete the project for both Option 1 and Option 2. Supplemental information, qualifications, resumes, and experience may be included in an Appendix.

A proposal that does not fulfill all requirements of the RFP shall be deemed non-responsive and excluded from the proposal evaluation process.
