Annual Contract – Lawn Maintenance for Cobb County Weed Ordinance

Questions submitted in writing

Question: What is the response time requirement once Cobb County tells the contractor that a property needs to be mowed?

Answer: **Five days is the standard response time. We do occasionally submit an expedited request that would need a two day response time.**

Question: For price #1 (1/2 acre or less), do you need to bag/remove the grass clippings or can you mow without a bagger and leave the clippings?

Answer: **The grass may be mowed without a bagger and the clippings can be left on the ground.**

Question: Does price #5 (lawn maintenance and clean up of debris) include the cost for mowing and debris removal or just the removal of the debris? If this includes mowing, what acreage is this for? Is it any acreage until we reach 4 Cubic Yards of debris?

Answer: **This line item is rarely used. The item is in place for a property where mowing debris may be requested to be removed. If needed, the officer will indicate the item on the grass cutting request form. The pricing is for debris removal only, separate from mowing. It is for any acreage up to the 4 Cubic Yards.**

Question: Will the measured acreage include the whole lot (including buildings/roadways, etc.), or just the grass areas? Who determines the measurement?

Answer: **The mowing area is determined by the officer completing the inspection. The measurement is calculated using the aerial GIS map and will be marked on the grass cutting request form as front, rear, right or left side. Generally the entire lot will need to be cut except for areas that have been left in a natural state.**

Question: Who would be responsible for the removal of debris that is not grass clippings? I.E. trash, old appliances, mattresses or whatever people dump on these sites? If the contractor is responsible, how is that priced?

Answer: There is no provision in the ordinance for removal of junk and debris. Any junk and debris left on the property must be removed by the property owner.
