Questions submitted in writing

Question:

On the second page of the bid document "Advertisement for Bids" it states that the Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act Affidavit form must be submitted. Then on Page 36, XXV, it states the form is not applicable. Please advise if form is required, and provide a copy

Answer:

The Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act Affidavit is not required.

Question:

Page 5, 13.6.2 states vehicle top speed of 65 MPH. NFPA limits top speed to 60 MPH.

Answer:

If the apparatus proposed by the bidder is over 50,000 lb. GVWR, it must be compliant to the NFPA 1901 requirements as shown below.

NFPA 1901 Section 4.15.3

If the combined water tank and foam agent tank capacities on the fire apparatus exceed 1250 gal (4732 L), or the GVWR of the vehicle is over 50,000 lb (22,680 kg), the maximum top speed of the apparatus shall not exceed either 60 mph (85 km/hr) or the manufacturer's maximum fire service speed rating for the tires installed on the apparatus, whichever is lower.
