Clarification for questions on Addendum 6

Question: Addendum 6 has created some confusion can you confirm which hours we should use.

The numbers do not add up based on addendum 6. With the elimination of route 35, 65 and 70 total hours for weekdays and Saturdays should be as follows:

Total Weekday Hours – 143,776.0256
Total Saturday Hours - 11,628.786
Total Annual Hours - 155,404.8116

The RFP indicates the following:

Total Weekday Hours – 114,655.87
Total Saturday Hours - 10,025.9976
Total Annual Hours - 124,681.8676

Response: The County does not know where the above hours came from. Exhibit 3 of the RFP indicates that for fiscal year 2010, total weekday revenue hours operated was 176,015.61 and total Saturday revenue hours were 15,893.34. Cobb County's 2010 fiscal year ended on September 30, 2010, so these numbers reflect the revenue hours actually operated in fiscal year 2010. On November 1, 2010, fiscal year 2011, CCT eliminated several trips on various routes which reduced the scheduled revenue hours of service. As we anticipate eliminating three bus routes effective July 2011, contractors should base their proposal on the number of revenue hours noted on the spreadsheet included in

Question: Based on the major service adjustments provided in addendum 6, we are requesting an extension of the submission date until June 15.
