Separate, sealed bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the construction of the aforementioned project will be received by the **COBB COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**, herein referred to as "**Owner**", at the offices of the **Purchasing Department, 1772 County Services Parkway, Marietta, Georgia 30008**, until **12:00 Noon** (local time) on **October 28, 2004**. The Bidder's name and address, the project name, project number, and State of Georgia Utility Contractor License number must be shown on the outside of the bid envelope. **No bids will be accepted after the 12:00 Noon deadline.** Those received late will be returned unopened.

Bids will be opened at 2:00 PM (local time) on **October 28, 2004**, in the **Purchasing Department bid room, Purchasing Department, 1772 County Services Parkway, Marietta, Georgia 30008**.

The Project consists of the construction of improvements to the solids handling and treatment systems at the R.L. Sutton Water Reclamation Facility. The improvements include the following:

1. Construction of a new Solids Process Building housing four new dewatering centrifuges, two fluidized bed incinerators and support facilities;
2. A new single, centralized odor control system comprised of two packed bed scrubbers arranged in series and a new packaged biofilter odor control system for the waste activated sludge wetwell;
3. Installation of four new thickening centrifuges and appurtenances within the existing dewatering building;
4. Construction of two new gravity sludge thickeners, a packaged biofilter odor control system and conversion of existing Primary Sludge Pumping Station No. 2 into a new Thickened Primary Sludge Pumping Station;
5. Conversion of existing chlorine contact tanks into ash basins;
6. Conversion of an existing blower building into a parts storage facility;
7. Miscellaneous improvements to existing Odor Control Building and Sludge Dewatering Building;
8. Demolition of a number of buildings, including but not necessarily limited to Primary Sedimentation Tanks 1 through 4, the Vehicle Maintenance Building, the abandoned Dissolved Air Flotation Thickeners, Chlorine Building No 2, Primary Clarifier Splitter Box, Scum Building, the two existing Grit Chambers, the existing Influent Channel, Primary Sludge Pump Station No 1, the interior of the existing Sludge Thickening Building, miscellaneous utilities, piping, roadways, sidewalks, concrete pads, etc.
9. Construction of a new fueling facility;
10. Yard piping, grading, paving and landscaping;
11. Other Work as shown on the Drawings and/or as specified herein.

Only contractors who have been prequalified specifically for this project with the Cobb County Water System prior to the first public notice of this advertisement are invited to bid. Bidders are required to have a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License.

BIDS FROM OTHER THAN PREQUALIFIED CONTRACTORS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Bids will be accepted only from Prequalified Contractors who are listed on the Plan Holders List, signifying that they have purchased a set of documents from the Engineer.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond prepared on accepted form, duly executed by the bidder, in the amount of five per cent (5%) of the bid.

Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids, to evaluate bids, and to accept any bid which in its opinion may be for the best interest of Owner. Any bids submitted that do not include a duplicate of Section 00300 and a copy of the bid bond as specified in the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. Owner has the right to add to and delete from the contract once it has been awarded. Award, if award is made, will be to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

The successful bidder for this contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory performance bond and labor and material payment bond, each in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the bid.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
