NORTHWEST COBB WRF EXPANSION - PROJECT NO.T4016

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF COBB COUNTY, GEORGIA

Separate, sealed bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the construction of the aforementioned project will be received by the **COBB COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**, herein referred to as "**Owner**", at the offices of the **Purchasing Department, 1772 County Services Parkway, Marietta, Georgia 30008**, until **12:00 Noon** (local time) on **September 9, 2004**. The project name, project number, and State of Georgia Utility Contractor License number must be shown on the outside of the bid envelope. **No bids will be accepted after the 12:00 Noon deadline**. Those received late will be returned unopened.

Proposals will be opened at 2:00 PM (local time) on September 9, 2004, in the Purchasing Department Bid Room, Purchasing Department, 1772 County Services Parkway, Marietta, Georgia 30008.

The Project consists of the following major elements: expansion of the existing Proctor Creek influent lift station with two 600 hp pumps; a new forcemain from the plant to the treatment facility; minor modifications to the headworks and equalization basins; one new 70-foot diameter primary clarifier; expansion of the existing primary sludge pump station; new scum screening facility; retrofit of eight existing aeration basins with fine bubble diffused air; one new 110-foot diameter secondary clarifier with return activated sludge pumps; effluent filters modifications including media and controls replacement; ultraviolet disinfection system expansion; influent and effluent flow measurement structures; new effluent pumps; modifications to the existing positive displacement blowers and sludge holding tanks; new chemical feed and storage facilities; modifications to the existing dewatering building, including the addition of a fourth belt filter press and odor control; new blower/electrical building; modifications to the existing control building and original effluent pumping station; expansion of the existing maintenance building; and onsite yard piping and miscellaneous structures.

Only contractors who have been prequalified with the Cobb County Water System for this project are invited to bid. Bidders are required to have a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License.

The Instruction to Bidders, form of Bid, form of Contract, Drawings, Specifications, forms of Bid Bond, Performance Bond, Payment Bond, and other Contract Documents are available for a non-refundable fee of **\$450** payable by check or money order at the offices of **Black & Veatch, 1145 Sanctuary Parkway, Suite 475, Alpharetta, Georgia 30004**. Bids will only be accepted from Bidders who are listed on the Plan Holders List, signifying that they have purchased a set of documents from the Cobb County Water System.

Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check or a bid bond prepared on accepted form, duly executed by the bidder, in the amount of five per cent (5%) of the bid.

Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids, to evaluate bids, and to accept any bid which in its opinion may be for the best interest of Owner. Any bids submitted that do not include a duplicate of Section 00400, Section 00410, and Section 00430 as specified in the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. Owner has the right to add to and delete from the contract once it has been awarded. Award, if award is made, will be to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

The successful bidder for this contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory performance bond and labor and material payment bond, each in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the bid.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
